**SCHEDULE "A"**

**BEING AN AMENDMENT  
TO THE SWIMMING POOL BYLAW NO. 1844/05  
BEING A BYLAW TO REQUIRE THE ERECTION AND  
MAINTENANCE OF FENCES AND GATES AROUND  
PRIVATE OUTDOOR SWIMMING POOLS INCLUDING HOT TUBS**

That the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Espanola enacts as follows:

- 1) That any customer of Espanola Regional Hydro installing a swimming pool, which would by Corporation bylaw, be required to be fenced in and where Espanola Regional Hydro's electrical meter would be located within the fenced in area, the owner would be required to re-locate his meter (at the owners expense) outside of the fenced in area and/or in a location acceptable to Espanola. Hydro. All electrical work would be as per Ontario Hydro electrical code.
- 2) Grounding and Bonding  
The metal parts of the pool in which the electrical equipment associated with the pool is:
  - a) not located within three (3) metres of the pool, or
  - b) suitably separated from the pool by a fence, wall or barrier, or
  - c) approved without bonding conductors

Need not be bonded or grounded to each other unless a problem from stray voltages from elsewhere arises.

**Read a first, second and third time and finally passed in open council on this 11<sup>th</sup> day of April 2006.**
