2013 Budget **Deliberations** The Clerk Treasurer/Administrator provided council with a overview of budget cuts that were made to the following departments since the 1st draft budget was presented:

Treasury, Administration, Provincial Offences, Health Services, Social Services, Planning & Land Development, Economic Development and Commercial Services. Additional possible savings in the amount of \$2500 in Cultural Activities were also discussed.

Staff was directed to "flag" the budgeted amount for elections and revisit it after budget deliberations have concluded.

Staff was directed to cancel the weekly ¼ page ad with the Mid

North Monitor and submit ads on an as needed basis. Direction was given to staff to cut the Doctor Recruitment budget by \$5000 and approach the surrounding municipalities to ask them for contributions that would offset this reduction. Staff was directed to prepare a motion stating that Council for the Town of Espanola does not approve of the Sudbury & District Board of Health motion #04-13, dealing with the reallocation of budgeted in-year surplus being exercised by a single individual.

Staff was directed to prepare a motion to repeal Bylaw 668/81 and donations made to the Seniors Citizen's Club be granted as requested based upon the conditions outlined in the charitable donations policy.

Staff was directed to cut the Care Van hours to 35 hours per

Staff was further directed to prepare a staff report to eliminate all honorariums.

Direction was given to move forward with selling the municipally owned building located at 91 Tudhope St.
